DETAILED SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Note: Your hunt tag must be visible at all times!

Thursday, March 22:

Noon - RV campers can begin setup in the park. Sites must be booked directly through Diamond Don's.

NOTE: NO METAL DETECTING IS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY ON THURSDAY. CHECK-IN ONLY.

Friday, March 23:

10am Overnight tent campers can begin arrival, setup. Check-in begins at 10am. Pick up your registration package (which includes your hunt tag) at the front gate. **After 7pm, pick up your packet Saturday morning.**

Hunting **FREE RANGE hunting opens at Noon** for anyone wearing a hunt tag, but is limited to areas on map supplied at check-in. Historic dump areas are open for detecting and sifting.

7:30pm All hunting ends for the day. Meet and greet other hunters at pavilion in the evening.

MAIN HUNT AREA FOR RELIC/SILVER HUNTS WILL REMAIN OFF LIMITS UNTIL DESIGNATED HUNT TIME ON SATURDAY.

Saturday, March 24:

7:00am Main gates open. Pick up registration packs and hunt tags.

7:30am FREE RANGE hunting in park begins. See map in your hunt pack for any areas that are off-limits.

9:00am Registration ends. Pre-hunt talks at Pavilion.

9:15am Gather at Pavilion for Relic Hunt for final details on how/where hunt will start.

9:30am - RELIC HUNT* (paid participants only). Civil War relics (minie balls, buttons, etc.) + prize tokens to dig. Hand diggers or small shovels only.

11:30am Relic Hunt field CLOSED TO ALL HUNTERS.

11:45am All major prizes awarded at Pavilion. Tokens found in Relic Hunt must be turned in at this time. Drawings will be held at this time for any unclaimed relic token prizes.

1:30pm - KIDS HUNT.* Limited to kids ages 12 and under.
2:30pm All prizes (including detectors and *Pro-Pointers*) will be awarded at the Pavilion after the end of hunt.

3:00pm Begin submissions for BEST FIND at Pavilion.

Saturday, March 24 (continued):

6:00pm Final turn-in time at the Pavilion for Free Range Hunt finds (up to one submission per person for each BEST FIND* category). All prize tokens found in Free Range Hunt areas must also be redeemed at this time.

6:30pm Judges announce BEST FINDS winners. Prize distribution for Free Range token finds.

7:30 pm End of hunting in all Free Range areas.

"Dark-30" (Approximately 8:30pm.) LIGHTS OUT HUNT* No flashlights, pinpointers or headlamps to be used; detectors only.

9:00 pm Prize redemption at the Pavilion for Lights Out Hunt tokens.

9:30pm - Campfire (weather permitting) and social time at the Pavilion.

Sunday, March 25:

7:30am Free Range hunt areas open.

9:30am Gather at Pavilion for final Silver Hunt info.

10:00am - SILVER HUNT* (paid participants only). Find coins, Noon plus tokens redeemable for detector prizes **and even gold coins.**

Noon Silver Hunt Field IS CLOSED TO ALL HUNTERS.

12:15pm Silver Hunt prize redemption at the Pavilion. All final prizes will be awarded, with drawings being held for all unclaimed Silver Hunt token prizes. Once all prizes have been distributed, Garrett will announce that all hunt fields are open to hunt, including Relic/Silver hunt fields.

3:00 pm **Final check-out time from Diamond Don's RV Park.** All guests who have not paid Diamond Don's to stay an additional night must check out of the park, as new guests will be checking in with their RVs in the afternoon.

NOTE: Schedule is subject to change (i.e. severe weather, etc.). Any revisions to schedule will be announced at the hunt by Garrett Hunt Staff.

Remember: Diamond Don's is private property. No metal detecting is allowed on the property except during these designated hunt time.

NOTE: A concession stand will be available on site in Diamond Don's RV Park for the purchase of food and drinks.
