Friday, April 9:

Overnight tent campers can begin arrival, setup.

Check-in begins at 10am. Pick up your registration package (which includes your hunt tag) at the Civic Center building. After 7pm, pick up your packet

Saturday morning.

Hunting FREE RANGE hunting opens at Noon for anyone

wearing a hunt tag, but is strictly limited to areas on map supplied at check-in. Begin finding special game tokens (such as Gold Coin Challenge tokens), and other Garrett

prize tokens.

7:30pm All hunting ends for the day. (Token redemption begins

on Saturday afternoon)

Saturday, April 10: 7:00am Main gates oper

Main gates open. Pick up registration packs and

hunt tags in Civic Center building.

7:30am FREE RANGE hunting in park begins. See map in

your hunt pack for any areas that are off-limits.

Pre-hunt talks in the Civic Center. Activities for the day 9:00am

are explained. Location of Relic Hunt site is revealed (within 2 miles of First Monday site). Hunters will need to

drive to the location and will be parked. Please carpool.

10:00am - RELIC HUNT\* (paid participants only). Civil War relics (minie balls, buttons, etc.) + prize tokens to 3:30pm

dig. Hand diggers or small shovels only. (Location will be revealed Saturday morning at 9am; maps provided to

paid Relic Hunt participants.)

Note: be sure to bring snacks or lunch, plus water, to the remote Relic Hunt location. There are no concession

vendors scheduled to be on that site. Portable toilets will

be available.

Turn-ins begin in Civic Center for Free Range tokens. Noon

4:30pm - 5:30pm	KIDS HUNTS.* Limited to kids ages 12 and under. Location near log cabin in First Monday park.
5:45pm -	All Kids Hunt prizes awarded at Civic Center.
6:15pm - 6:45pm	Relic token prizes awarded at Civic Center. <u>Tokens found in Relic Hunt must be turned in at this time</u> . Drawings will be held at this time for any unclaimed relic token prizes. Turn-ins of any Free Range tokens continues.
7:30 pm	End of hunting in all Free Range areas.
7:40pm	Announcements, Vaughan Garrett talk at Civic Center
"Dark-30"	(Approximately 8:30pm.) LIGHTS OUT HUNT* No flashlights, pinpointers or headlamps to be used; detectors only. Lowering your detector's Sensitivity is recommended.
9:00pm-ish	Prize redemption at the Civic Center for Lights Out Hunt tokens.

7:30am -Any Free Range tokens can be redeemed at the Civic Center.

9:00am Silver Hunt talks begin at 9:15 in Civic Center.

9:30am Silver Hunt participants prepare for start of hunt.

SILVER HUNT\* (paid participants only). Find silver 10:00am -

coins, plus tokens redeemable for detector

prizes and even gold coins. Those finding tokens should make their way to the Civic Center by noon.

Silver Hunt prize redemption at the Civic Center. All final

12:15pm prizes will be awarded, with drawings being held for

all unclaimed Silver Hunt token prizes. Following this, drawings will also be held for any other unclaimed prizes.

3:00 pm Final check-out time from First Monday Park. All

guests who have not paid First Monday to stay an

additional night must check out of the park.
